Membership shall be open to all Catholic co-educational schools including co-educational campuses. Members of SACCSS Inc. will be located in the north-west corridor of Melbourne and no further than 50km from the CBD.

SACCSS Colleges are expected

- To honour the Rules of SACCSS an Incorporated Association.
- To be involved in all Major Carnivals, Senior Sport and Premier League (where applicable);
- To attend SACCSS Inc. Committee meetings and Heads of Sport meetings by appropriate delegates;
- To contribute to the SACCSS Inc. community through active participation in the range of events and activities on offer where commitments made to competitions are honoured and given the highest priority;
- Commit and fully support the SACCSS Inc. Association Purposes and Sport in SACCSS School ethos
- to provide in writing a minimum of 6 months notice if ceasing membership.

Membership applications are to be made in writing to the Executive Officer of the Association a minimum of nine months prior to the start of the school year membership is sought. Principals or Delegate of current member schools will consider applications and acceptance will be a unanimous decision.

SACCSS Inc. will provide a response to an applicant no later than six months prior to the nominated start date for membership.
