# SACCSS SENIOR MALE AND FEMALE VOLLEYBALL

#### **RULES & RESPONSIBILITIES**

1. The home team is the first named team on the draw.

#### Home team duties:

- (a) Arrange venue with competing school.
- (b) The home school shall appoint a registered umpire
- (c) Organise match ball (for the Grand Final each team is to supply a ball (game ball selected by the referee)
- (d) Organise a scorer (a teacher or student)
- (e) Supply a first aid kit
- (f) After the game The Head of Sport of the HOME Team is required to enter the result within 24 hours and the AWAY Team Head of Sport is then required to confirm the entered score. Where they are unable to enter a result, they should e-mail the Executive Officer ASAP.
- (g) Collect the umpire's votes for the SACCSS Best and Fairest.
- (h) SACCSS Net Height set to Boys 2.35m/ Girls 2.25m
- (i) All matches shall **commence at 1:15pm**

#### Away team duties:

- (a) Organise a scorer (a teacher or student)
- (b) Supply a first aid kit
- 2. The Competition shall be played in accordance to the current, published FIVB Rules of the Game. The current FIVB Rules of the game are available at <a href="https://www.FIVB.org">www.FIVB.org</a>
  - 2.1 Teams are to consist of a *maximum 10 players only for the day*, with 6 in rotation at any one time. Teams must field *a minimum of 5 players* for a game to commence.
  - 2.2 Teams must have a minimum of four (4) eligible players present at the start of the match
  - 2.3 A replay of a point shall be called by the referee where:
  - an object enters the field of play (i.e. ball) during active play.
  - When time is called, the ball is immediately dead, (no points awarded unless point was completed).
  - 2.4 Any body part can be used to hit the ball.
  - 2.5 Rules governing the serve:
  - If the ball hits the net on the serve and continues into the opposition's court it is considered 'play on'.
  - Points can be won by either side regardless of who served.
  - Only one (1) service attempt is permitted per service. The server must hit the ball within 8 seconds from when the referee signals for the service.
  - 2.6 A maximum 1 minute will be provided between sets and a maximum of 30 seconds is allocated for the duration of a timeout
  - 2.7 All matches are played to the best of five (5) sets
  - Sets one-four will be played to 25 points, if a two-point advantage has not been achieved, the set will continue until the leading team has obtain a two-point advantage.
  - The fifth and final set will be played to 15 points with a two-point advantage.
  - 2.8 In the event of the Umpire being later than 15 minutes after the official starting time of the match, the 2 Coaches shall confer in an attempt to reach a mutual agreement as to who shall umpire the match.
  - 2.9 Teams requiring forfeiting a game must notify the Executive Officers and the opposing team as soon as possible. A forfeit will result in the game being awarded to the team available to compete, they will receive four match points and a win margin score of 3 sets to 0.
  - 2.10 Players will be Yellow Carded or Red Carded (just like soccer) for offensive conduct or aggression. First Yellow Card is a warning. A second Yellow Card will equal a Red. If a player receives a Red Card, they are off for the rest of the match and may not be replaced.
  - 2.11 The Umpire shall have the power to order off and report any player for misconduct to the Executive Officer who shall forward details to the Principal and Sports Coordinator of the player concerned. The Umpire shall inform the player's Coach of his intention to lodge a report. The Principal and Sports Coordinator of the player reported shall deal with the case.
  - 2.12 A player sent off is required to report to their Coach to have their name recorded.

#### **Competition Format**

1. The following points shall be awarded for each match:

Win = 4
 Draw = 2 (only to be awarded if game is abandoned due to heat)
 Loss = 0

- 2. Ladder Scheme: ladders for all Premier League Volleyball competitions will be based on the following
  - Total Match Points
  - Set Difference
  - Sets Against
  - Sets For
- 3. The Divisions for the 2024 competition are as listed at the front of the 2024 SACCSS Handbook.

#### 13 Injury Time

In the event of a serious injury where a player cannot be moved from the court until assessed and deemed medically safe to move, the game time shall be suspended for up to **15 minutes.** 

If appropriate to do so, the game may be moved to another Court within the same venue to be continued. (Considerations: player welfare/ supervision/ nature of injury)

Once player is moved from the court the game recommences with a fresh service of the team who the last point, and the game is played out in its entirety.

If at the 15-minute mark the player has not been moved and it was not appropriate to move the game and remaining players to another court the game result would be either:

- (a) If the match is in the third set and a team is leading 2 sets to 0, the game is awarded to the leading team.
- (b) If the match is in the 3rd set, where the match is at 1 set each and the leading team has reached 15 points or more with a two-point advantage the game is considered viable and the game awarded to the leading team.
- (b) If neither of the above situations are achieved, the match is abandoned and to be rescheduled for another time. (TBC by SACCSS EO and competing schools)
